2006 FALL SEASON TEAM INFORMATION PACKET

This following information is about the BC Baseball League's Fall League. This information will allow teams to reserve a spot in the appropriate fall division of the BC Baseball League. The BC Baseball League's Fall Season Program emphasizes development in a competitive atmosphere. We utilize a continuous batting order during the fall in order that teams may use this time to move players into positions that might not otherwise play in the spring/summer months as they begin their planning for the next season. A continuous batting order is really free substitution of all players at the game. Coaches also have the option of not using this tool simply by declaring their intent to use a continuous batting order or not for that game. Also, the Fall Season provides an opportunity for those 8U teams to experience kid-pitch before the start of their 9U season next spring.

The 2006 Fall League will be played on Fridays, Saturdays and/or Sundays, similar to last year. At this time, we are considering playing the 8u, 9u and 10u age groups on Friday night and/or Saturday afternoon/evening. We also are considering playing the 11u and 12u on Saturday afternoon/evening (with some Sunday games as a possibility) and playing the 13u and 14u on Sunday afternoon/evening (with some Saturday games as a possibility). Game times being considered for Friday night are 6PM and 8:10PM; times being considered for Saturday are 3PM, 5PM and 7PM or 4PM, 6PM, 8PM; times being considered for Sunday are 3PM, 5PM and 7PM. As in past years, teams would be scheduled for one doubleheader per week. The 2006 Fall Season again will start with a pre-season tournament (which is included in the cost of the fall season registration) for the 14u to 8u teams. This tournament is scheduled for the Twin Oaks Complex in Columbia on for August 25-27, 2006. The Fall Season league games will begin the weekend after Labor Day, September 11-13, 2006, and conclude no later than October 13-15, 2006, including rain dates. The tournament will be a USSSA qualifier for the 2007 season for the 14U through 9U teams.

This packet contains details on all of the fall divisions. Most importantly, it contains a Fall Season Team Application Form. This Team Application Form is due with a \$300 reservation fee on or before the Team Application Deadline of Wednesday, August 16, 2006. Following the Team Application Deadline, your team will be registered with the USSSA and your team insurance will be purchased. The remainder of your league fee will be due on or before August 25, 2006. Once your Team Application Form is received, you will be forwarded the remainder of your Team Registration Packet.

2006 FALL SEASON INFORMATION

High School Division – 18 & Under: These are teams which are made up of current high school age players. Teams will be scheduled for a total of 12 games. Teams will be scheduled for two games on Sunday (or Saturday), beginning September 10 with the division concluding at the end of October. Games are tentatively scheduled for Columbia and Jefferson City. Games will be seven innings in length and will be played with a 2-hour time limit. Teams will play a doubleheader or a split doubleheader. Players in these age groups will be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball rules are used for these divisions, except in the BC Baseball League's Fall Division teams will be allowed to use a continuous batting order. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. **League: \$1,100 per team.**

High School Division – 16 & Under: These are teams which are made up of incoming high school age players which are currently no older than sophomores in high school. Teams will be scheduled for a total of 12 games. Teams will be scheduled for two games on Saturday (or Sunday), beginning September 9 with the division concluding at the end of October. Games are tentatively scheduled for Columbia and/or Jefferson City. Games will be seven innings in length and will be played with a 2-hour time limit. Teams will play a doubleheader or a split doubleheader. Players in these age groups will be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball rules are used for these divisions, except in the BC Baseball League's Fall Division teams will be allowed to use a continuous batting order. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. **League Fee: \$1,100 per team.**

14 & Under and 13 & Under Divisions: These are teams which were 13U and 12U teams during the spring/summer of 2006. (Teams will be separated into a 14U Division and a 13U Division, dependent upon the number of teams entered in these divisions, with a possibility of one or two crossover games vs. the older/younger division.) Teams will be scheduled for the pre-season tournament and 10 league games. Teams will begin play in the BC Baseball League Fall Pre-Season Tournament on August 25-27, 2006. League play will begin on the weekend of September 8-10, 2006. Teams will be scheduled for a doubleheader on Sunday (as the primary day) or Saturday. Sunday games are tentatively set to begin at 3PM or 5PM with possible game times of 3PM, 5PM or 7PM on Sundays. Teams will play a doubleheader or split doubleheader when scheduled. Games will be played at the Twin Oaks Sports Complex. Teams will play on fields set with 80-foot base and 54-foot pitching distances. Games will be seven innings in length and will be played with a 1 hour, 45 minute time limit. Players in these age groups will be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball Rules (with BC Baseball League modifications as listed on the league web site) are used for these divisions. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. Practice time will be available at Twin Oaks for teams in this division. (Rain Date Note: Weekends in October will be used for rain make-ups, if needed.) **League Fee: \$1,000 per team.**

12 & Under and 11 & Under Divisions: These are teams which were 11U and 10U teams during the spring/summer of 2006. (Teams will be separated into an 11U Division and a 12U Division, dependent upon the number of teams entered in these divisions, with a possibility of one or two crossover games vs. the older/younger division.) Teams will be scheduled for the pre-season tournament and 10 league games. Teams will begin play in the BC Baseball League Fall Pre-Season Tournament on August 25-27, 2006. League play will begin on the weekend of September 8-10, 2006. Teams will be scheduled for a doubleheader on Saturday (as the primary day) or Sunday. Saturday games are tentatively set to begin at 4PM or 6PM with possible game times of 4PM, 6PM or 8PM on Saturdays. Teams will play a doubleheader or split doubleheader when scheduled. Games will be played at the Twin Oaks Sports Complex. Teams will play on fields set with 70-foot base and 50-foot pitching distances. Games will be seven innings in length and will be played with a 1 hour, 45 minute time limit. Players in these age groups will NOT be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball Rules (with BC Baseball League modifications as listed on the league web site) are used for these divisions. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. Practice time will be available at Twin Oaks for teams in this division. (Rain Date Note: Weekends in October will be used for rain make-ups, if needed.) **League Fee: \$1,000 per team.**

2005 FALL SEASON INFORMATION

10 & Under and 9 & Under Divisions: These are teams which were 9U or 8U teams during the spring/summer of 2006. Teams will be scheduled for the pre-season tournament and 8 league games. Teams will begin play in the BC Baseball League Fall Pre-Season Tournament on August 25-27, 2006. League play will begin on the weekend of September 8-10, 2006. Teams will be scheduled for a doubleheader on Friday evening or Saturday (as the primary days) or Sunday. Friday games would be 6PM and 8:10 p.m. while Saturday games are tentatively set to begin at 4PM or 6PM with possible game times of 4PM, 6PM or 8PM on Saturdays. Teams will play a doubleheader or split doubleheader when scheduled. Games will be played at the Twin Oaks Sports Complex. Teams will play on fields set with 65-foot base and 46-foot pitching distances. Games will be six innings in length and will be played with a 1 hour, 45 minute time limit. Players in these age groups will NOT be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball Rules (with BC Baseball League modifications as listed on the league web site) are used for these divisions. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. Practice time will be available at Twin Oaks for teams in this division. (Rain Date Note: Weekends in October will be used for rain make-ups, if needed.) **League Fee: \$900 per team.**

8 & Under Kid Pitch Division: This division will be organized into an Instructional League for the 2006 Fall Season whereby players may sign up individually and/or teams as a group. These players/teams will be provided a Pitching Clinic prior to the season (which will begin on the weekend of September 8-10, 2006). Teams will be scheduled for a mostly single games on Friday evening, Saturday or Sunday. Games will be played at the Twin Oaks Sports Complex. Teams will play on fields set with 60-foot base and 40-foot pitching distances. Games will be six innings in length and will be played with a 1 hour, 30 minute time limit. Players in these age groups will NOT be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball Rules (with BC Baseball League modifications as listed on the league web site) are used for these divisions. Practice time will be available at Twin Oaks for teams in this division. **More Information on this division will be posted to the BC Baseball League website (www.bcbaseball.org) in the next few weeks. League Fee: \$600 per team or \$60 per individual player.**
