2009 FALL SEASON TEAM INFORMATION PACKET

This following information is about the BC Baseball League's Fall League. This information will allow teams to reserve a spot in the appropriate fall division of the BC Baseball League. The BC Baseball League's Fall Season Program emphasizes development in a competitive atmosphere.

The 2009 Fall League will be played on Saturdays and/or Sundays, similar to the past few years; however, unlike past years, no games will be scheduled on Saturdays of Missouri home games. We also will have an option for teams to play on Wednesday and Thursday (if needed) to allow teams an opportunity to play on weeknights if they are unable to play on particular weekends. And, we will avoid the Thursday night of Missouri's home game against Nebraska.

We will schedule 9u and 10u, 11u and 12u age groups on Saturday afternoons and/or evenings., although some Sunday games could be a possibility in case of inclement weather. We also will schedule 13u and 14u age groups on Sunday afternoons and/or evenings, although some Saturday games could be a possibility in case of inclement weather. As in past years, teams would be scheduled for one doubleheader per week. The 2009 Fall Season again will start with a pre-season tournament (which the entry fee is included in the cost of the fall season registration. Teams will only be required to pay a gate fee. This tournament is scheduled for the Twin Oaks Complex and Atkins Field Complex in Columbia on for August 27-30, 2009. The Fall Season league games will begin the Wednesday and Thursday before Labor Day, September 2-3, 2009, and conclude no later than October 17-18, 2009, including rain dates. Again for the 2009 season, there will be a second fall season tournament (the Mid-Missouri Fall Championships), this year scheduled for September 18-20,2009. (NOTE: Both tournaments will have high school age divisions for 2009.) Both tournaments will be USSSA qualifiers for the 2010 season for all teams. League teams will be able to play in the Mid-Missouri Fall Championships for \$400, which includes the entry and gate fees.

This packet contains details on all of the fall divisions. Most importantly, it contains a Fall Season Team Application Form. This Team Application Form is due with a \$300 reservation fee on or before the Team Application Deadline of Wednesday, August 12, 2009. Following the Team Application Deadline, your team will be registered with USSSA and your team insurance will be purchased. The remainder of your league fees will be due on or before August 28, 2008. Once your Team Application Form is received, you will be forwarded the remainder of your Team Registration Packet. 2009 FALL SEASON INFORMATION

High School Division – 18 & Under/16 & Under/15 & Under: These are teams which are made up of current high school age players. The teams will be scheduled appropriately against teams of similar/same age, although all will be grouped into the same division. Teams will be scheduled for the pre-season tournament and 8-10 league games. Teams will begin play in the BC Baseball League Fall Classic on August 27-30, 2009. Team also will have an option to play in the Mid-Missouri Fall Championships (September 18-20, 2009) for an additional fee. League play will begin on the weekend of September 13, 2009. Teams will be scheduled for two games on Saturday or Sunday, beginning September 13 with the division concluding October 17-18. Games will be scheduled the Twin Oaks Complex or the new fields at the Boone County Fairgrounds. **(Ideally, all games would be scheduled on Sundays at the two grass infields at the Boone County Fairgrounds; however, total number of teams and team availability will dictate the final schedule.)** Games will be seven innings in length and will be played with a 2-hour time limit. Teams will play a doubleheader or a split doubleheader. Players in these age groups will be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball rules are used for these divisions. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. **League: \$1,100 per team.**

14 & Under and 13 & Under Divisions: These are teams which were 13U and 12U teams during the spring/summer of 2009. (Teams will be separated into a 14U Division and a 13U Division, dependent upon the number of teams entered in these divisions, with a possibility of one or two crossover games vs. the older/younger division.) Teams will be scheduled for the pre-season tournament and 8-10 league games. Teams will begin play in the BC Baseball League Fall Classic on August 27-30, 2009. **Teams also will have an option to play in the Mid-Missouri Fall Championships (September 18-20, 2009) for an additional fee.** League play will begin on Wednesday September 2, 2009. Teams will be scheduled for a doubleheader on Sunday (as the primary day) or Saturday. Also games may be played on Wednesday or Thursday. Games will be played on Sunday afternoons and/or evenings, depending (of course) on total number of registered teams. Teams will play a doubleheader or split doubleheader when scheduled. Games will be played at the Twin Oaks Sports Complex. Teams will play on fields set with 80-foot base and 54-foot pitching distances. (NOTE: When 14U teams play 14U teams, fields will be set with 90-foot base and 60-foot-6-Inch pitching distances.) Games will be seven innings in length and will be played with a 1 hour, 45 minute time limit. Players in these age groups will be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball Rules (with BC Baseball League modifications as listed on the league web site) are used for these divisions. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. Practice time will be available at Twin Oaks for teams in this division. (Rain Date Note: Weekends in October will be used for rain make-ups, if needed.) **League Fee: \$1,100 per team.**

12 & Under and 11 & Under Divisions: These are teams which were 11U and 10U teams during the spring/summer of 2009. (Teams will be separated into an 11U Division and a 12U Division, dependent upon the number of teams entered in these divisions, with a possibility of one or two crossover games vs. the older/younger division.) Teams will be scheduled for the pre-season tournament and 8-10 league games. Teams will begin play in the BC Baseball League Fall Classic on August 27-30, 2009. **Teams also will have an option to play in the Mid-Missouri Fall Championships (September 18-20, 2009) for an additional fee.** League play will begin on the Wednesday of September 2nd and the first weekend will be on September 13, 2009. Teams will be scheduled for a doubleheader on Saturday (as the primary day) or Sunday. Games will be played on Saturday afternoons and/or evenings, depending (of course) on total number of registered teams. Teams will play a doubleheader or split doubleheader when scheduled. Games will be played at the Twin Oaks Sports Complex. Teams will play on fields set with 70-foot base and 50-foot pitching distances. Games will be six innings in length and will be played with a 1 hour, 45 minute time limit. Players in these age groups will NOT be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball Rules (with BC Baseball League modifications as listed on the league web site) are used for these divisions. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. Practice time will be available at Twin Oaks for teams in this division. (Rain Date Note: Weekends in October will be used for rain make-ups, if needed.) **League Fee: \$1,100 per team.**

2009 FALL SEASON INFORMATION

10 & Under and 9 & Under Divisions: These are teams which were 9U or 8U teams during the spring/summer of 2009. Teams will be scheduled for the pre-season tournament and 8-10 league games. Teams will begin play in the BC Baseball League Fall Classic on August 27-30, 2009. **Teams also will have an option to play in the Mid-Missouri Fall Championships (September 18-20, 2009) for an additional fee.** League play will begin on the September 2 but the first weekend will be September 13, 2009. Teams will be scheduled for a doubleheader on Saturday (as the primary day) or Sunday. Games will be played on Saturday afternoons and/or evenings, depending (of course) on total number of registered teams. Teams will play a doubleheader or split doubleheader when scheduled. Games will be played at the Twin Oaks Sports Complex. Teams will play on fields set with 65-foot base and 46-foot pitching distances. Games will be six innings in length and will be played with a 1 hour, 45 minute time limit. Players in these age groups will NOT be allowed to wear metal cleats. USSSA Baseball Rules (with BC Baseball League modifications as listed on the league web site) are used for these divisions. Two umpires will be scheduled for all games in this division. Practice time will be available at Twin Oaks for teams in this division. **League Fee: \$1,100**
